SOLAR PANELS FOR UKRAINE

The Rotary Club of Lander, Wyoming is converting solar panels to phone chargers for the people of Ukraine, where the power grid has been extensively damaged and cell phones are vital to schools, hospitals, and defense units in resistance to the Russian invasion. The cost to convert and ship one small solar panel to charge four cell phones is approximately \$150. 100% of our donations will be used to purchase, convert, and ship solar panel phone chargers to Ukraine. Before the panels are shipped, we'll have an opportunity to write messages of support and encouragement to the people of Ukraine on the back of the panels.
